HUMAN RIGHTS FOUNDATIONS (HRF)



PART 1 : MEMORANDUM OF ASSOCIATION

Article 1: Name :

The name of the Society shall be HUMAN RIGHTS FOUNDATIONS (hereinafter referred to as "HRF" or the 'Society' in short, which expression shall have the same meaning as the HUMAN RIGHTS FOUNDATIONS, registered under the Societies Registration Act, 1860 as applicable to National Capital Territory of Delhi (NCT of Delhi). HRF shall be a national body working for the promotion of human rights and freedom related issues;

Article 2: Registered Office :

The Registered office of the Society shall be situated in the National Capital territory of Delhi (NCT of Delhi), presently at S. No.7, Ground Floor, 'L' Portion, Vijay Market, Madanpur Khadar, Sarita Vihar, New Delhi 110 076, but may be located at any such other place as may be decided by the Society from time to time.

Article 3: Area of Operation : Whole of India

Article 4: Aims & Objectives :

The aims and objects of HRF shall be as follows :

HUMAN RIGHTS

- 4.1. To create awareness among the public about civil, political, social, economic, and cultural rights and freedoms enumerated in the United Nations Universal Declaration of Human Rights; and also to undertake activities with a view to enabling people to enjoy these rights;
- 4.2. To protect Human Rights and prevent its violation; and to work for the restoration of violated human rights and freedoms; and to build up stronger democracy;
- 4.3. To develop national and international cooperation in the area of human rights; and to intervene wherever there is a violation of human rights and to take up the issue to United Nations Organization, International agencies and to various government departments at National and State levels.
- 4.4. To spread legal awareness and education in the sphere of human rights and freedoms, forms and methods of its protection;
- 4.5. To set up formal and informal educational institutions to spread legal education in the area of promotion and protection of basic human rights and freedoms in India;
