



- 4.6 To conduct regular or occasional seminars, conferences, lecture programs, workshops, and meetings with the objective of attaining the basic objective of HRF, including building up or inculcating habits and characters that are congenial to cultural, community and societal living, and through which to build up a nation worthy of conducting its affairs based on democratic principle and spirit; and to conduct classes and courses on human rights and to provide certificates to successful candidates.
- 4.7 To conduct survey, study, and research with a view to collecting data and information in respect of all sorts of human rights and freedom violations and discriminations;
- 4.8 To act and provide legal supports and aid for providing fair and equitable justice to poor and unreached people irrespective of their caste, creed, region or religion;
- 4.9 To help needy and poor people especially women and children in their attempt towards getting their human rights and freedoms restored and protected;
- 4.10 To work for the rehabilitation of people especially women and children whose human rights have been violated by wrongful confinement and wrongful action by the authorities;
- 4.11 To educate and work towards bringing back the people engaged in illegal activities and put back in national mainstream;
- 4.12 To build up a strong team of youth volunteers and put them in various national building activities and to maintain peace, law and order whenever and wherever there is a need;
- 4.13 To work towards solving the issues of fundamental rights as and when required by lawful means;
- 4.14. To help consumers in getting compensation against deficiency in quality and services and also to work towards bringing in necessary reforms in consumer redress sector;
- 4.15. To demand from the elected representatives of people such as Members of Panchayats, Municipalities, Corporations, Assemblies, and Parliament for fair and responsible utilization of public funds and resources;
- 4.16 To watch closely the functioning of bureaucracy and governance with a view to pointing out the deficiencies and to suggest viable and innovative methods for quality functioning and governance; and To work towards bringing in complete transparency in all governmental functioning and dealings including purchases, appointments and other affairs;
- 4.17 To issue Identity Cards to the human rights activists who are associated with human Rights Foundations (HRF) to protect human rights values and to join hand with Government of India to support the UN frame work.
- 4.18 To encourage the State to adopt international humanitarian conventions to improve the lives of citizens;
