- 4.53 To work for the welfare of rural people irrespective of caste, colour, religion, politics, financial status ...etc.
- 4.54 To form legal cells.
- 4.55 To begin libraries and other related activities to promote Art and Cultural programmes.
- 4.56 To gather people from throughout the country to work for the fulfillment of the objectives of HRF.
- 4.57 To develop equality, brotherhood and co-operation among people.
- 4.58 To work for the economic, cultural and social well-being of public.
- 4.59 To do benevolent and charity activities in all spheres.
- 4.60 To operate and function educational institutions.

Article 5: Emblem and Flag

Human Rights Foundations (HRF) has an emblem. A Circle with Blue colour in which the name Human Rights Foundations comes encircled and in the middle in light sky blue shade A Dove to represent Peace, Two Grains to represent Nature, A Scale to represent Justice, and the letters HRF in the circle. Just below the circle official website address (www.humanrightsfoundations.org) is given. Below the circle and the website there will be a base where the words Justice, Peace and Protection of Nature written in it. It has a flag. Its width will be one third of the length. A white colour based Emblem of Human Rights Foundations (HRF) will be centered on a blue background.

Article 6: Utilization of Income & Property:

That all the income, earnings and moveable or immoveable properties of the Society shall solely be utilized and applied for the promotion of its aims and objects as set forth in the Memorandum of Association, and no profit thereof shall be paid or transferred directly or indirectly by way of dividends, bonus, profits, or in any manner whatsoever to the present or the past members of the Society or to any person claiming through any one or more of the present or past member/s of the Society, and that any past or present member/s shall have any personal claim on any moveable or immoveable properties of the Society or any member shall make any profits whatsoever by virtue of his/her membership in the Society;
